The program will teach participants how to safely operate a dump truck, fire truck or straight truck, both on high-ways and logging or back roads. Topics covered include all relevant aspects of driving these classes of vehicles including an air brake course, coupling and uncoupling procedures, defensive and winter driving, load distribution, log books, vehicle inspections, preventative maintenance, vehicle weights and dimensions, and transportation of dangerous goods. The course consists of a classroom program, yard training, and practical drive time. A certificate will be issued to participants upon successful completion of the program, and a vehicle for the road test is also included in the cost of the course.

**Prerequisites:** To enroll in this program participants must be at least 18 years of age, hold a valid G license, meet MTO medical requirements, and possess an education level of Grade 10 or equivalent.

**Course Length:** 69 Hours (Approximately 4 Weeks) 32hrs - class, 22hrs – driving and 15hrs of yard work.
