The East End Family Health Team partners with Northern College to improve access to health care. Our team of experienced health care professionals includes; nurse practitioners, physician, psychiatrist, registered nurses, registered practical nurse, pharmacist, dietician, and social workers.

See us for your immunizations, management of basic illnesses and injuries (sore throats, skin ailments, sprains and strains), sexual and mental health needs. Walk in clinics are available for students and staff between 3:00 - 4:00 pm Monday-Thursday. During the months of September and October we will be holding these walk in clinics from 2:30 - 4:00 pm to improve access for students requiring preparation for student placements.

All students who require immunization at the clinic **MUST BRING THEIR IMMUNIZATION RECORD WITH THEM.** You can obtain an immunization record from the Health Unit in your community which can be faxed to the East End Family Health Team. All students and staff utilizing the clinic must bring in a valid health card.

If you are without a family doctor, you may choose to roster with the East End Family Health Team. When you become a rostered patient with the family health team you will have access to full services and won't be restricted to the walk in clinic only.

Referrals to community services including public health, mental health, and diabetes information network are made on an individual basis.
