PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The General Arts and Science program is the most flexible program at Northern College providing you with access to a wide variety of postsecondary options. While exploring different areas of study and working toward a college diploma, you earn credits that can be transferred to other college programs or to a university. The program focuses on developing enhanced skills in communication, critical thinking and computer literacy to build a solid foundation for future studies and career success.

Tuition: approx. \$3,000 / year, plus the cost of books.

Minimum Entrance Requirements

Ontario Secondary School Diploma (OSSD – new curriculum) with Grade 12 English (C or U or equivalent) and Grade 10 Mathematics (MFM2P or equivalent), OR mature student status (an applicant who does not have a high school diploma or equivalent, and will have reached the age of 19 years on or before the start of the program). Mature students may be admitted after testing. Call the Admissions Office at (705) 235-7222 for more details.

 - CM1006 Communications Fundamentals I

4 Electives, e.g. Canadian Government, Health Awareness, Life Management II, Math Fundamentals II
