

Government of Canada Introduces Further Restrictions on International Travel

Greetings Everyone,

As you may know, Transport Canada has introduced further restrictions on international travel.

What this means is that you will have to comply with the following recently announced testing and quarantine requirements:

- You will be required to [book a stay of at least three days at a nearby government-approved hotel in one of the four landing cities in Canada](#) prior to your departure to Canada. Please visit <https://www.canada.ca/en/public-health/services/diseases/2019-novel-coronavirus-infection/latest-travel-health-advice/mandatory-hotel-stay-air-travellers/list-government-authorized-hotels-booking.html> for the hotel booking information; **hotel booking phone number for people outside of North America: 1-613-830-2992**
- You will be tested for Covid-19 at your point of entry (Montreal, Toronto, Calgary, Vancouver) into Canada.
- If you test negative, you can complete the remaining 11 days of your quarantine in accordance with Northern College's Covid-19 readiness plan (staying in approved on-campus residences which continue to be eligible for this portion of the quarantine).

More information about latest international travel to Canada

Recent restrictions released on February 12th include:

“All travellers arriving to Canada by air, as of February 22, 2021, with some exceptions, will be required to take a COVID-19 molecular test when they arrive in Canada before exiting the airport, and another toward the end of their 14-day quarantine period.

With limited exceptions, air travelers, will also be required to reserve, prior to departure to Canada, a 3-night stay in a government-authorized hotel. Travelers will be able to book their government-authorized stay starting February 18, 2021. These new measures are in addition to existing mandatory pre-boarding and health requirements for air travelers.

Finally, **at the same time on February 22, 2021, all travelers**, whether arriving by land or air will be required to submit their travel and contact information, including a suitable quarantine plan, electronically via **ArriveCAN** before crossing the border or boarding a flight.”
