

Underground Mine Support Service Worker

Scope of Work:

A&M provides services to mine sites that improve the function and safety of sites. We are seeking full time employees to fill these positions. A&M operates at mine sites all around the Sudbury basin 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. Accordingly, prospective employees must have a reliable vehicle to get them to work up to one hour outside of downtown Sudbury, and are required to have a valid drivers license for work.

A&M has entry level positions available for employees looking to work underground. Training is provided and paid for by A&M, in addition to a health and dental benefits package (after 3 months) and PPE is provided.

Job Responsibilities:

A&M's core business is in underground waste management and the cleaning and maintenance of latrines and refuges. All entry level staff are expected to complete these roles. Additional training may be provided once employees have demonstrated excellence and as opportunities arise.

Regular responsibilities include:

- **Waste management** – sorting, handling and packaging waste for proper disposal.
- **Latrine/Refuge Cleaning and Maintenance** - Workers will clean and maintain all latrines and refuges in the mine, including restocking supplies and pumping out latrines as needed.
- **Operating Mobile Equipment** - various equipment (RTV, Jeep, forklift, mine cat, etc) is used. Pre-operational checks and safe operation are required.
- Dust suppression - mactac/water spraying
- **Industrial Cleaning** – sanitizing and cleaning to reduce COVID transmission risks.
- **Ventilation Dispatch** – organization and management of vehicular traffic in and out of areas with ventilation restrictions.
- **Pump repair and maintenance** – assessment, diagnosis and repair of sandpiper pumps.

Shift Structure

- Minimum 4 shifts per week at 10 hours per shift. Generally 7:00-5:00 for both day shifts and night shifts. OT is available.

Compensation:

- \$21.00/hr starting wage. Wage increases possible after 3 months and every year thereafter.
- \$4.00/hr premium for night shift workers.
- Employees are eligible for our defined medical and dental benefits program after 3 month probationary period. There is no cost to workers for this program.
