Greetings from Northern College!

We hope you are doing well. Here is an update about Northern College and the DLI approval listing.

Northern College is now on the DLI list of post-secondary institutions with an approved COVID-19 Readiness Plan which was published on November 17th, 2020 on IRCC's webpage.

Please begin to prepare for your travel *if you have a valid study permit now* and you wish to travel to the college.

1. Please read the document "[A Guide for International Students in Canada Arriving from Broad](#)" issued by the IRCC for more information on travel to Canada during the pandemic.
2. Download the [Pre-Travel form](#) to complete and sent to [international@northern.on.ca](mailto:international@northern.on.ca)
3. Prepare your quarantine plan before you travel to Canada

If you plan to **quarantine off-campus**, please provide a detailed quarantine plan within [the Pre-Travel form](#) to be sent to [international@northern.on.ca](mailto:international@northern.on.ca), which will include:

- address where you are quarantining
- name of the property owner
- phone number
- arrangement of food delivery
- daily monitoring plans

If you plan to **quarantine at the Timmins Campus**, you must inform the International Department in the [Pre-Travel form](#) to be emailed to [international@northern.on.ca](mailto:international@northern.on.ca).

Once we receive the completed Pre-Travel form with your quarantine plan, we will issue your travel guidance and support documents. Then, you can book your flight.

4. Send your flight booking details to [international@northern.on.ca](mailto:international@northern.on.ca), by filling in the [Flight Information form](#) including:
  - Departure date and time
  - Connecting flight date and time
  - Arrival date and time

If your flight is cancelled/delayed, or your travel plans change, please message 1-705-266-4193 (WhatsApp) as soon as possible.

5. Complete 14-day quarantine once you arrive at your destination.
  - Go directly to your place of quarantine
  - Do not visit any friends or go to any stores

Please note: You must arrange and have your COVID-19 test on or after the 14th day of your quarantine with the local COVID-19 test center. You can only end your quarantine once you receive your negative test result, per the Ministry requirement. Anyone who violates the quarantine requirements will be reported to local law enforcement to be penalized accordingly. A valid negative COVID-19 test result will be required when you access any of the college campus buildings.

Once your 14-day quarantine is complete and you have a valid negative test result, you may come to campus if you have a face-to-face class or have an appointment on campus. You must complete a pre-screening form before entering any campus building.

6. Please download and log in to the iCent App to complete the pre-screening form each day you need to be on campus to present to the door attendant. More information on the iCent App can be found at [www.northernc.on.ca/covid-19-coronavirus](http://www.northernc.on.ca/covid-19-coronavirus).
