



NOTICE OF INTENTION

We hope you're enjoying the summer and all it has to offer. Northern College is in the process of gearing up for a new academic year and we would like to invite you to join us again.

All 2nd, 3rd and 4th year returning students are required to register for the new 2021-2022 academic year by completing the enclosed **PAYMENT/REGISTRATION** form. For tuition fee schedules you may refer to our website www.mynorthern.ca. Please note you must return the form to **Student Services** immediately in order to complete your registration.

Your **non-refundable tuition and fee registration deposit must** be submitted with the registration form (both pages completed) by July 30th to guarantee your seat in your program of study. If you are sponsored, we need an official letter from your sponsor to confirm this status. Domestic students who anticipate receiving OSAP must make a confirmation payment of \$250.00 by July 30th. Students are reminded that full tuition or first semester and ancillary fees are due by September 3rd, 2021 or a late fee of \$150.00 will apply. See the second page of the Tuition Fee Payment/Registration Form for due dates.

Students who do not have clear promotion standing into the second, third or fourth year must contact the appropriate Program Coordinator in order to confirm course registration and program eligibility. You are encouraged to do this as early as possible.

The majority of post secondary programs will continue for a 30-week academic year. Orientation will take place on **Tuesday, September 7th** and classes will begin on **Wednesday, September 8th** for all 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th year students.

A \$250 non-refundable deposit is required upon confirming your offer. Please note that any past-due fees must be paid before you can register for your program. The balance of semester fees must be paid prior to the start of the semester. For more details and dates, see back of page.

How do I pay?

- **Pay Online at Northern College**

Go to MyNorthern at www.mynorthern.ca. Login with your *username* and *password* which is located on your *Offer of Admission*. Select *MyAccount* located on the left and start the process. **This is the easiest and fastest way to pay.**

- **Pay at a Canadian Bank or Financial Institution**

Payments made at your bank will take approximately 5 business days to be sent to Northern. These payments are available at the 5 major banks: CIBC; BMO; RBC; Scotia; and TD. The Financial institutions we do not accept online payments from are credit unions and Caisse Populaires. Please allow sufficient time to avoid missing the deadlines.



Timelines:

July 30th, 2021

A deposit of \$250 (non-refundable) is due or upon confirmation of offer.

September 3rd, 2021

Fall semester fees including ancillary fees are due. Full fees (two semester) may also be paid.

September 7th, 2021

A late fee of \$150 will be applied if fall semester fees are not paid in full.

Students who redirect their OSAP funding to the college to pay their tuition fees may be exempt from the late fee.

January 3rd, 2022

Winter semester fees are due.

January 7th, 2022

A late fee of \$150 will be applied if winter semester fees are not paid in full.

If you have applied for OSAP funding, your winter semester fees are due within 7 days of receiving your OSAP funding, otherwise, the late fee will apply.

Students who redirect their OSAP funding to the college to pay their tuition fees may be exempt from the late fee.

***Note: Spring semester dates will be posted on our website as soon as they are available.

I UNDERSTAND AND AGREE THAT:

- All fees must be paid according to the above mentioned timelines.
- The College will withhold my transcript, diploma, certificate and other academic documents until all fees have been paid in full.
- I acknowledge that I am not officially registered until all fees owing from previous years have been paid in full. I can contact Student Services to review options.
- I further acknowledge that after the 10th day of scheduled classes in each semester, if I withdraw from the College with or without formal notice, I am responsible for any outstanding tuition assessment, residence, or any other charges still owing to the College in that semester.
